

## Sixth Form – Business Attire Guidelines

<b>Compulsory Items Colour Guidelines:</b>		
<p><u>Trousers, Skirts, Dresses, Jumpers and Blazers:</u> Either plain/one colour only (black, navy, grey) or predominantly black, navy or grey with understated, traditional pattern (herringbone, light pinstripe)</p> <p><u>Shirts:</u> White/cream, pale/pastel colours only, either plain, with a light stripe, or understated, traditional pattern</p>		
<b>Male Students:</b>	<b>Female Students:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Collared shirt, short or long-sleeved, suitable for wearing with a tie, to be tucked in</li> <li>Smart, full-length trousers</li> <li>Plain black/brown formal leather or leather-style shoes</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Smart formal blouse or collared shirt, short or long-sleeved but not sleeveless, with a fairly high neckline</li> <li>Smart full-length trousers</li> <li>Smart skirt, knee-length or below the knee</li> <li>Dresses with capped, short or long sleeves and a fairly high neckline, knee-length or longer</li> <li>Plain black/brown formal leather or leather-style low-heeled* or flat shoes</li> </ul>	
<b>Optional (Male/Female)</b>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Tie, solid coloured or with understated, traditional pattern</li> <li>Plain belt with modest buckle</li> <li>Long-sleeved jumper or cardigan, finely knit</li> <li>Jacket or blazer</li> </ul>		
<b>Jewellery, Piercings, Makeup and Hair Styles:</b>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2 pair of stud earrings – two per ear maximum</li> <li>1 plain bracelet, 1 plain necklace, 1 ring, 1 watch</li> <li>Clear nose or cartilage piercing</li> <li>Makeup should be subtle and natural, and nail varnish may be worn but colours must be subtle and natural*</li> <li>Hair should be neat and tidy at all times, and hair colour should be on the natural colour spectrum*</li> </ul>		
<b>Not Allowed:</b>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Tight-fitting or revealing items</li> <li>Jeans/denim or denim-like material</li> <li>Lycra or stretchy material</li> <li>Chinos or skinny trousers</li> <li>Cropped or ¾ length trousers</li> <li>Metallic coloured zips</li> <li>Skirts above the knee or excessive skirt slits</li> <li>Bare midriffs and off-the-shoulder tops</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Blouses with low necklines, slits or cut-outs</li> <li>Polo, sports and sweatshirts</li> <li>Bold stripes, checks or patterns</li> <li>Rolled-up sleeves</li> <li>Tops or ties displaying large logos, emblems, lettering or slogans</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Trainers or patterned shoes</li> <li>Embellishments on shoes such as metal bars</li> <li>High heels</li> <li>Overly excessive hair accessories</li> <li>Visible undergarments</li> <li>No tattoos</li> <li>Prominent nose or cartilage piercings</li> </ul>
